It's been a pleasure because the ministry we do is real. Serving the poor and assisting those most in need is at the heart of the Gospel. As we read in Matthew's gospel, "whatever you do to the lease of these brothers or sisters, you do to me." This is who we are everyday. Watching our staff serve in their various capacities has been a pleasure. Working with those who lead are Community Cupboard and Closet has been a pleasure. Building relationships with other like-minded people in the neighborhood has been a pleasure. Praising God with all of you on the weekends has been a pleasure. Thank you for the many ways you witness your faith!

It's been a learning experience because my eyes have been opened to new people and new realities. I am deeply grateful to the Deaf community at St. Augustine. Your love for each other and this parish is an inspiration. Your patience with me and willingness to help me along meant the world to me, and my understanding of the Deaf community and the issues you face will remain with me the rest of my life. I love each of you.

I worked with those in need while at St. Noel, but the need among our neighbors here is at a much deeper level. Walking and talking with those who are unhoused and often unwanted has been transformative for me. St. Augustine will always be a place where all are welcome, and being the Outreach Coordinator here was wonderful!

Finally, I learned a little bit about what it means to be from the Southside. I'll never truly get it, but your toughness, loyalty, and spirit were present whenever we talked and evident at every event as you stepped forward to serve. We need to be open to new people and new ideas, but having people who know the history and preserve the memories is invaluable to this community.

I will be working for the Social Action Office of the diocese and serving parishes in Lake & Geauga Counties as well as eastern Cuyahoga County. I plan to bring all that I have learned from you to my new position and am grateful to God for the time I was given at St. Augustine Parish. Know of my prayer for you and this community always.

I approach this responsibility with great dedication, an open heart, and a sincere desire to listen, collaborate, and grow together in faith. I firmly believe that parish life flourishes when we each bring our gifts to the table and work together as one body in Christ.


