## COORDINATOR'S COLUMN

As I continue to settle into my role as Parish Life Coordinator, I have been reflecting on what the Coordinator's Corner in our parish bulletin might look like. While Anthony often shared reflections on the Sunday readings, I will begin by using this space to keep you informed about the life and happenings of our parish. My hope is that this corner will not only provide updates, but also foster connection and communication as we walk together in faith.

One of the projects currently underway is the lighting in the church. As is both diocesan policy and good practice, we are seeking multiple bids before moving forward. So far, we have received one bid, and unfortunately, another company stopped responding after initially working with us for several months. A third company has suggested that replacing the bulbs with newer technology might be a simple and effective solution, and they are even sending us samples to test. While I am a bit skeptical that this alone will solve the issue, it is worth exploring as part of the process.

In addition to the lighting, there are several smaller projects around the parish that also need attention. In the coming weeks, I will share a list of these projects in the bulletin with the hope that some of our parishioners may be able to lend a hand.

Thank you for your patience, prayers, and support as we continue to care for our parish. Together, even in our simplicity, we strive to live the Gospel message in all that we do.

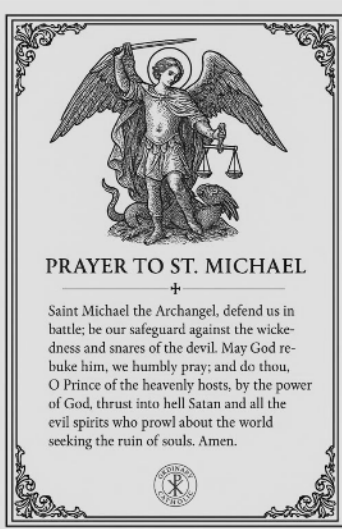

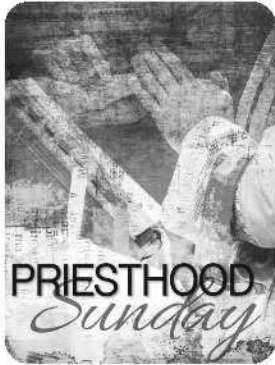

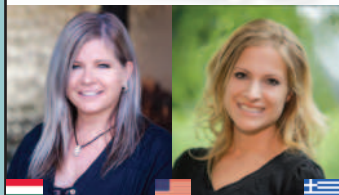
